2009 Fremont Sailing Club Results

In the FJ fleet, Mark Phillipps and Dana Rowley took first place in the Spring Series. Keith OHara with various crew won Summer and Fall Series, resulting in 2008 winner Mark transferring the FJ trophy to Keith as winner of the 2009 season.

Lidos continued their A fleet / B fleet scheme from last year. The series winners in the B fleet, Sidney Lee for Spring Series, Hans and Helga Wolff for Summer Series, and Jim Lechner for Fall Series, each enter the A fleet. Among the Lido As, Butch Michel won Spring and Summer Series, and tied on points with Bruce McDevitt in the Fall. Butch had five bullets while Bruce had four, so Butch gets the Lido A Fall Series plate to complete his collection.

For their season trophy, the Lidos compete as one big group. Going back to the scores as reported in previous Windjammers, but now assigning points *without* splitting the fleet, we get the total points in the big table in this Windjammer. Butch Michel comes out on top, and gets the 2009 season trophy from last year's winner Jack Navarra

In the Open Class, attendance of was high enough for an award, per our standing rules, only in the Summer Series, won by Roy Jordan in his Sunfish. Roy keeps the perpetual trophy; he is the 2009 season winner.

The El Toro starting line was quite full through the spring, but only two *members* attended 60% of the races. More members were in the mix for Summer and Fall Series, so we have awards to give, both won by Art Lange. For the season overall, Greg Morrill transfers the trophy to 2009 season winner Art Lange.


