## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* 2009–2012.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The three Series are open to all current members of the Fremont Sailing Club. Each Series comprises three scheduled regattas on the dates listed in section 5.

*In addition*, we welcome guest sailors to compete in individual regattas for a \$5 entry fee.

Registration is by sign-up sheet at each individual regatta. Guests and members are scored together in the individual regattas.

### 3 CLASSES OF BOATS

We plan separate starts for  
FJ,  
Lido-14,  
el Toro, and  
Open class.

The open class is timed and corrected using a handicap table based on the Portsmouth Yardstick, with no wind-strength correction.

### 4 FEES

The club requires a \$5 race entry fee from guest sailors, but not from sailors who were enrolled in the City of Fremont sailing classes for 2009.

The city of Fremont requires a \$7 launch fee, with a season-pass option.

### 5 SCHEDULE

Fall Series: May 2, May 23, Jun 13  
Summer Series: Jun 27, Jul 18, Aug 1  
Fall Series: Aug 15, Aug 29, Sep 12

Three races are planned for each race day. A skippers' meeting is held at 11:30am on each regatta day at the grassy area northwest of the launch ramps.

Registration is at the same location, from 10:30am until the skippers' meeting.

First warning sound is scheduled for noon.

### 6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any amendments to the sailing instructions will be announced at the skippers' meetings.

### 7 VENUE

Lake Elizabeth is located within Fremont Central Park:
