FSC GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

Commodore Roy Jordan called the meeting to order at 19:50 hours at Beck's Steak House.

Commodore Jordan thanked Gwen Locke and Kathy Federico for making the arrangements for the Awards Banquet, and thanked those present for attending.

The minutes of the September 12, 2010 General Meeting were approved as printed in the September Windjammer.

Commodore's Report: Roy reviewed the year and mentioned the following:

- a. **Adult Sailing Classes:** This year we held two beginner classes, which were both well attended with 12 students in each and two intermediate classes where were not well attended. The second intermediate class was cancelled due to too few students.
- b. The two city employees who attended both our beginner and intermediate class conducted the City's youth sailing camp. The youth camps had over 40 kids, (ages 9-13), participating and were met with lots of enthusiasm and the kids enjoyed getting wet and capsizing.
- c. Thought that having the BBQ's on the first, middle and final race days respectfully of the Spring, Summer, and Fall Series was very successful.
- d. Thanked the (i) standing finish committee of Joyce Andrews, Kathy Federico, and Nancy Tucker for always being there on station, (ii) various instructors who helped with the sailing classes, and (iii) 2010 FSC Board for their hard work in assisting the commodore in making the year a success.
- e. The city wants to hold three beginning adult and one intermediate sailing classes next year. The city may provide a paid as-

sistant or two to assist us with the classes.

- f. The city's scow will be brought up to shape prior to next springs' sailing season.

El Toro Report: Helga announced that the annual El Toro Christmas party will be held on Friday December 10, 2010 at the home of Aad and Mary Rommelse. Bring toys for the Toys for Tots.

FJ Report: The FJ' will be sailing the mid winters at Richmond.

Lido Report: The Lidos will be holding their annual Christmas party at the Navarro home on December 5th. Bring gifts for Toy for Tots drive.

Treasurers Report: Kathy announced we are still solvent.

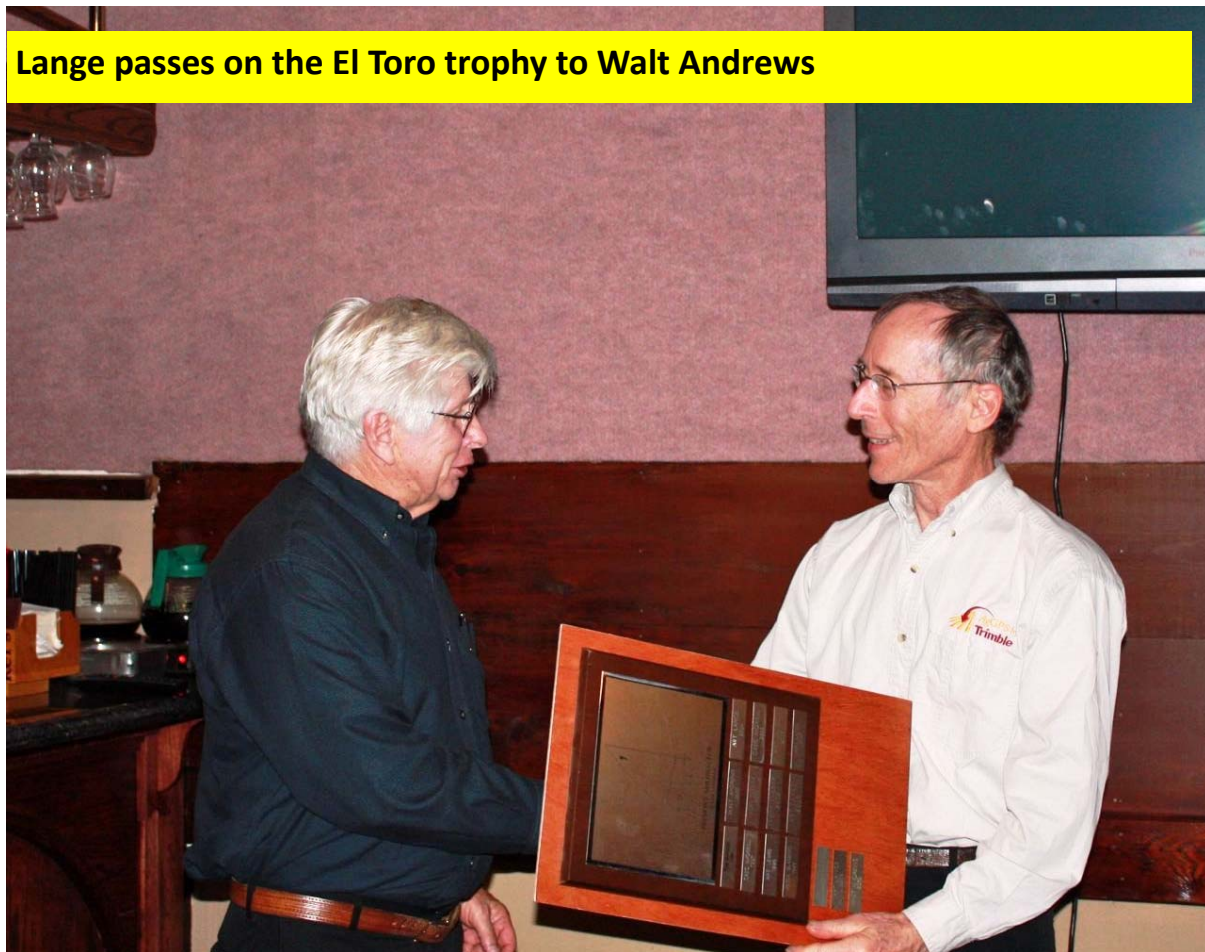

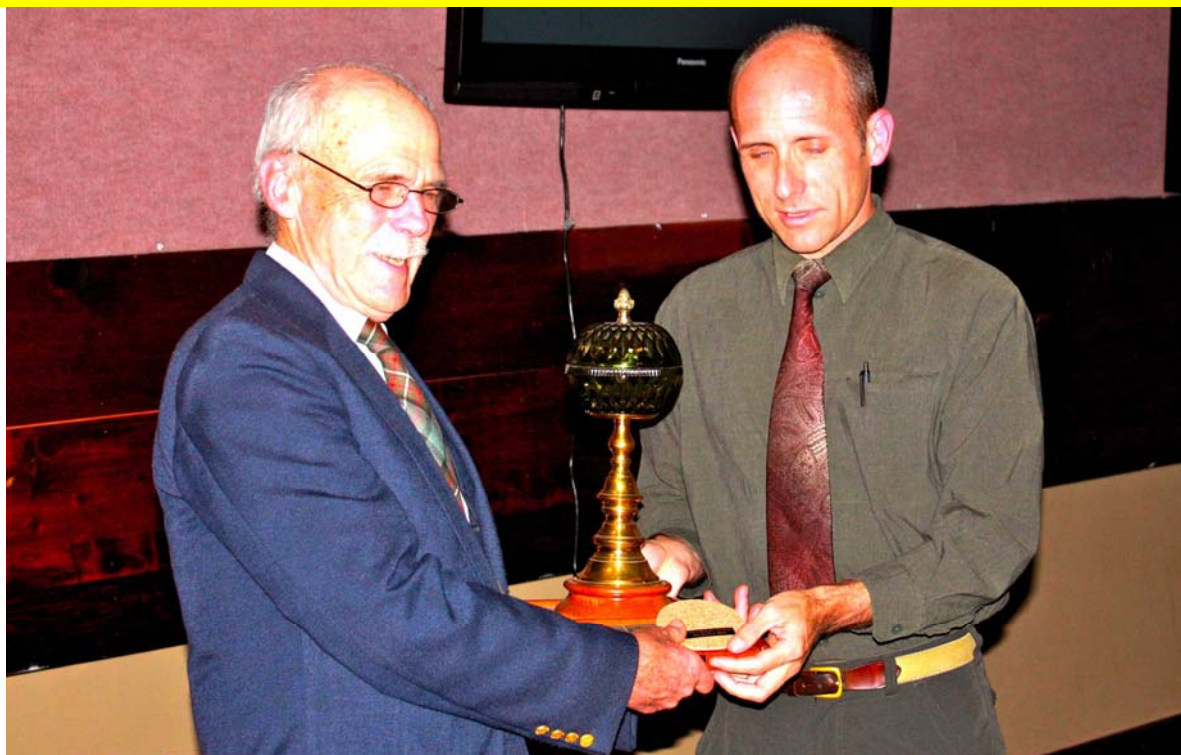


Joyce Andrews wins the 2010 Coffey Cup Award.

Harold and Maria Ho receive the 2010 Lido Trophy.



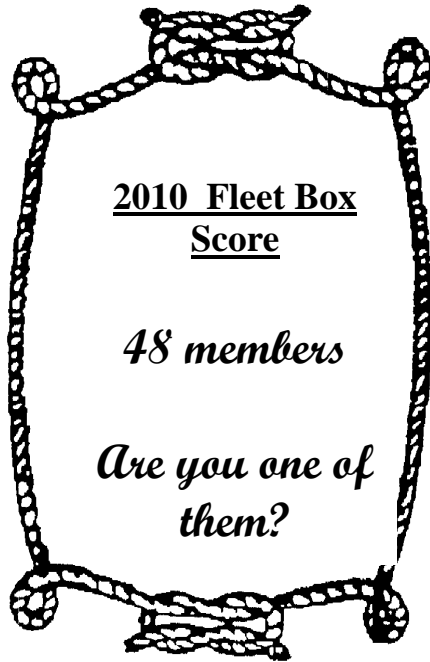

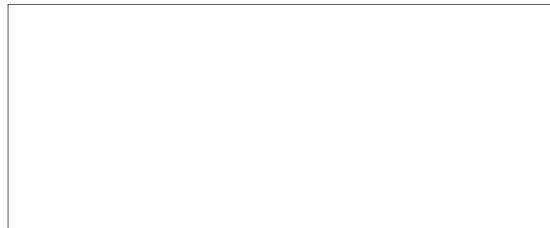
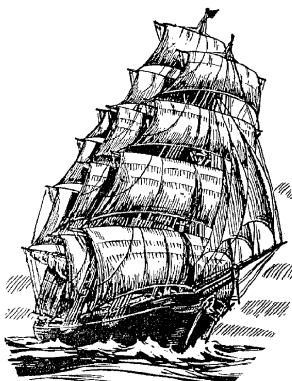
